I remember being in a gospel meeting as a teenager, and at one point the preacher asked everyone in the room single question: "Who is the person in this room who has influenced you the most as a Christian?" He then made a request: "I want each of you to rise and shake hands with the one who most influenced you to follow Christ."

All over the church auditorium people went to one another and encouraged one another by saying: "Thank you." Many went to parents. Others went to Sunday school teachers. Some went to the preacher. The longest line, though, formed in front of a woman in her late 70s. She had never taught a class or filled any prominent role in the life of that congregation, but for many decades her quiet life of consecration had touched more people than anyone else. In worship, in her home, and in the community, she had led many to Christ.

When Peter wrote, he knew that the power to persuade always came from our spirituality, not our ability- *it should be that of [ our ] inner self, the unfading beauty of a gentle and quiet spirit, which is of great worth in God's sight* (1 Pet. 3:4). When we don't feel like that we have a prominent place in the church do not confuse this with worth or ability. In fact when you read your Bible it is usually those who are *not* prominent who are the *most* valuable in God's sight.

If we were to form lines today, who would be in your line? And whose line would *you* be in? Let us take a moment today and thank those who have encouraged us along the way.
