We don't miss our son until he leaves for college, or we don't miss our daughter until she leaves for the Navy. We rarely think about ways to show appreciation and gratitude for mom until she leaves on business or for Dad until he is put in the hospital.

When Paul wrote to the church in Colossae, he told them that his wish was for them to be a church that was "abounding in gratitude" (Colossians 2:7). I think that we ought to practice gratitude in our homes by voicing and displaying words and acts of thanksgiving. It does not take any time at all to say "Thank you" or "I appreciate all you do." I think when we get into the habit of conveying thanks we then become thankful people.

Maybe we here at UNA can practice the same thing. Every person appreciates gratefulness. It gives us a sense of self-worth and strengthens our confidence in ourselves and our family. This week, think of small ways to show your appreciation to family members here at church. The more grateful we sound, the more grateful we are. I hope that when people come here to church, they notice a family that is "abounding in gratitude," and I hope they appreciate it enough to join us.


