

Identifying Treasure

In 1698, the Spanish Navy launched the *San Jose*, a enormous 3-masted galleon ship designed to transport valuable items back to the Capital of Spain. This ship was designed not just to carry the cargo, but protect it. It was equipped with 64 cannons that featured elaborately carved dolphins. In 1708, the ship was engaged in battle and was sunk off the coast of Cartagena, Columbia. When it sank, the ship was said to have been carrying 11 million 4-dabloons (coins of 27g of 92% gold), silver coins, and emeralds that were taken from the mines of Bolivia. The entire cargo is still believed to be intact.

On November 27, 2015, The Columbian Navy discovered an old cargo ship at the bottom of the sea. There was great speculation about what ship it might be and whether or not it truly was the famous *San Jose*. But all doubts were put to rest when the images from the dive photographs showed details of dolphins. There are many sunken ships at the bottom of the ocean; but only one that has dolphin-carved Cannons. The find was called the "Holy Grail of Shipwrecks."

Like the story of the sunken ship, many people are searching for treasure. They are looking for peace and contentment and purpose in life. Contrary to what our society and culture will advocate, true peace and joy cannot be identified by the cargo we carry or the size of our ship. We too have been carved into. The Prophets speak of God's people as those who have God's law and will carved onto their hearts and minds (Jer.31:31-34; Heb. 8:10). Jesus reminds us that when others are searching for heavenly treasure, they will not recognize it in people who merely give attention to power and possessions. Instead, he says "everyone will know that you are my disciples, if you love one another" (John 13:35).

We've all been marked and sealed by the Holy Spirit (Eph. 1:13). It is a spirit of goodness, kindness, faithfulness, gentleness and self-control. These are the distinguishing marks of true treasure. As people search for what they have lost, I hope they too can recognize treasure when they see it. More importantly, I hope we allow our own carvings to still be seen.
