Hidden Treasure

In the first thirty years since its founding in 1909, the small French automobile company Bugatti produced only 8000 vehicles. But what it lacked in production, it made up for in performance. The Bugatti automobiles were said to be a masterpiece of craftsmanship, and were often referred to by the media of the day as the “cutting edge of technology. In 1937, Bugatti made the Atalante type 57S coupe. In fact, they only produced 17 of them. In June of that year, Francis Curzon, a British Naval Officer and member of Parliament, ordered one new from the factory. Over the next few years, this rare automobile passed through a few other hands before finally being bought by Dr. Harold Carr. But Dr. Carr suffered from obsessive compulsive disorder, and in his later life became a recluse. No one ever saw Dr. Carr out of his home, and the rare Bugatti coupe was never heard from again...until fifty years later.

In 2007, Dr. Carr passed away and his family opened up the house to discover that their reclusive relative was also an unbelievable hoarder. His house and garage were filled from top to bottom with junk. And most of it was either thrown away or given to other family members. One of Dr. Carr’s nephews opened up the garage, and after moving years of collectibles out of the way, he discovered the rare Bugatti untouched since his uncle parked it there in 1960.

When I read that story, it made me wonder how many of us store away our earthly treasures, and cover them up with more junk? More importantly, how many of us are storing away or covering up the spiritual treasures in the back of our minds and not utilizing the wonderful gifts that God has used to bless our lives?

In Ephesians 1:17, Paul prayed on behalf of the church for the Lord “to give [them] spiritual wisdom and insight so that [they] might grow in [their] knowledge of God.” Paul believed that gifts from God should not only be received, but used and maximized to their greatest potential. We have all been given the tools to not only realize our own salvation, but to make salvation within the reach of those around us. To be a child of God is a gift. Don’t waste it. Don’t neglect it. And please don’t cover it up for your family to find only after you’re gone.
