*“No one can serve two masters. Either you will hate the one and love the other, or you will be devoted to the one and despise the other. You cannot serve both God and money (Matthew 6:24).*

It's a well-known passage, but we forget that Jesus changes his wording at the end of his statement. He begins by saying, “No one can...” but then concludes by saying, “YOU CANNOT!” Jesus is making two separate points here. First, he is telling us that a person should not attempt to divide his attention. And second he is telling us that it is impossible to multitask.

One cannot serve both God and money. One cannot be married to his spouse and “married to his job.” We can't have one house payment and then attempt to have a second. It is not only a bad idea; it is an impossibility. In the end we are married to neither, and both houses will be foreclosed. The reason this is true is due to both the nature of being human and the nature of Masters.

When we attempt to serve something, whether it be God, money, our employer, our ambition, or even a hobby, the very nature of devotion is that we become wholly devoted to it. It means that we must give our all. If we divert our attention away, then we are no longer devoted. In the same way, the very nature of a master demands our *entire* devotion. So, if we are not giving our all to who or what we serve, it cannot be our master.

There's an old story about a farmer whose prized cow gave birth to two calves. One calf was red and the other was white. He came into his house rejoicing and told his wife that because he had been so blessed, he had decided to sell one of the calves and give the proceeds to the Lord. When his wife asked which calf he would sell, he told her that it didn't matter because he would raise them and care for them equally. But one day, the farmer came in with a sullen face and grim demeanor. He looked to his wife and said, “The Lord's calf died.”

We never mean to serve two masters. But when trying times come our way and financial loss takes place, I'm sure that it comes as no surprise that it's our dedication to the Lord that always suffers first.

We cannot serve two masters. This is not only a suggestion; it is an undeniable fact. We must choose the path we walk and stay on it. When we depart from what we know to be true and right, a master will lose his service...and a servant will lose his master.
