

To All Una Folks from the Elders,

We are so very excited to tell you that Una Church of Christ will have the doors open for a return to worship at the building Sunday, May 31 at 9 AM, unless unforeseen circumstances should arise. The Spanish-speaking service will resume later on June 21 and will be at 12 Noon. The following apply until further notice:

- No Sunday School classes, no Children's Church and Nursery will be closed.
- Sunday and Wednesday PM services will continue on-line.
- The building will be sanitized prior to both worship services by teams of volunteers.
- Every other row of pews will be taped off to maintain social distancing.

Only attend services if you can answer "NO" to the following five questions:

- 1) In past 14 days have you been in close contact with a confirmed case of COVID-19?
- 2) Are you experiencing a cough, shortness of breath, or sore throat?
- 3) Do you have a fever, or have you had a fever in the last 48 hours?
- 4) Have you had new loss of taste or smell?
- 5) Have you had vomiting or diarrhea in the last 24 hours?

The Elders, assisted by a team of our members, have developed the following practices for our Sunday AM worship service. EVERYONE IS URGED AND EXPECTED TO SACRIFICE PERSONAL LIBERTIES AND ABIDE BY THESE PRACTICES **OUT OF LOVE AND CONSIDERATION FOR OTHERS**, EXPECIALLY THOSE WHO ARE MOST AT RISK TO THE CORONAVIRUS. We believe these to be both prudent and reasonable precautions.

- Plan on arriving 15 MINUTES early to allow time for these steps.
- Be seated at least 6 feet apart at all times, except members of the same household
- Everyone over the age of 2 is expected to wear a mask. Masks will be available at the doors if you do not have one.
- Everyone is expected to have their temperature taken at the doors by non-contact scanning (less than 100.5° F).
- Everyone is expected on entering to use the hand sanitizer available at each door.
- No hand-shaking or hugging. "Air hugs" are ok.
- Disposable individual communion kits will be available for pickup at the doors
- Remove your mask only for the Lord's Supper. Replace immediately following.
- Contribution – baskets at the doors for non-contact deposit as you leave the auditorium..
- Parents are expected to assure their children maintain social distancing from others.
- To avoid congestion in aisles and halls, remain seated to be dismissed by rows at the end of service. Remember social distancing. Keep your mask on until outside the building.

*Older adults and people who have severe underlying medical conditions like heart or lung disease, high blood pressure, or diabetes seem to be at higher risk for developing more serious complications from COVID-19 illness. If you fall into this group, **please carefully consider whether you return at this time.** All our services will continue to be available on YouTube and Facebook for your convenience.*
