God uses uncertain times to grab our undivided attention. During those uncertain times, God seems to accomplish the most in our lives. But what should we be doing in the meantime?

Consider This

1. Has God ever grabbed your undivided attention? How did He do so, and what did He seem to want? What changed afterward?
2. What is the significance of Paul's advice in the book of Philippians, given his personal experiences with uncertainty and hardship? How does his advice seem impractical, and how can we apply it to our lives during uncertain times?
3. How do we reconcile the idea that God's best work is done during uncertain times, considering the fear and discomfort that uncertainty often brings?
4. What does it mean to "present" our requests to God, and how is this different from just praying about something?

Apply This

In times of uncertainty, God provides peace that can replace anxiety, worry, and insecurity. We attain this peace by recognizing our dependence on Him and presenting our deepest needs, hopes, and fears in prayer
